June 10th, Corpus Christi Sunday, the bishops wish to use this feast day to highlight national immigration reform. To reflect on the struggle of immigrants, pray for a just reform, and urge parishioners to be informed. Archbishop Niederauer is inviting the faithful June 10th at 3 p.m. to parade from Mission Dolores to the Cathedral for a 5 p.m. Mass.

Corpus Christi procession dated back to the 11th Century as a response to the heresy of Berengarius of Tours who denied the presence of Christ in the consecrated bread and wine. The Belgium Blessed Juliana of Mount Cornillon (1193-1258), promoted a festival that eventually became extensive throughout the Church. The faithful brought their faith for the Eucharist onto the street, organizing processions filled with pageantry and beauty and celebrity to give honor to the Holy Eucharist. They would conclude by erecting an altar to celebrate Holy Eucharist. Vatican II changed the name Corpus Christi to the Body and Blood of Christ, Pope Paul VI.
