Three-part Series: The Swiss Guards, the Pope's Police

<u>Part-III</u>: The Swiss Guard costumes are famous for their bright colors and colorful attire. There is a historical misconception that the uniforms were designed by Michelangelo. Not so. They were designed in 1914 by a member of the guard. All the guards

have to be male, celibate, and their personal lives must be beyond reproach. They have their own choir, sport teams. Since this is their 500th year of existence, a group of guards marched from Switzerland to Rome, a month long journey through Italy, in memory of coming to the defense of the Pope, in 1506. The entire group survived the march with no drop-outs along the way. They have never been on strike or fail to turn up for duties.

As much as people visit Rome to see the Pope, they would be very disappointed if they do not have a photo with a Swiss guard.
