Gospel: Luke 12:32-40

The Gospel continues the instruction about possessions from last week's Gospel of the rich man and his full barns. This time the setting is from an eschatological context dealing with specific guidance on how one can act responsibly with possessions. The section of Luke images a wedding feast and the master returning, and his servants are prepared for him. The master is delighted at their watchfulness, that he actually joins them and becomes a servant also. Faith, and all of life is lived in the expectation of the

Son's return. The time of the arrival is unknown, but the coming is sure. The meaning of possessions, wealth, is understood in the anticipation of the master's return. Therefore, one has to have an attitude of the understanding and the meaning of wealth concerning the end times. Luke is saying, we will have to give an account to God of how we used what we have been given in this world.
