Early Christians repeated this story of the widow's fighting spirit, and the judge to one another. The accent sometimes fell on one character and sometimes on the other. Most could easily feel empathy with the widow. She had no clout in the community. She did not know the mayor of the town, or any county commissioner who might pull strings for her to have her case heard. All she could do was hound the judge, at the city gate, on the street, in the shops, at the court. Finally she defeated the judge without giving him a black eye. The widow became a model of how to pray and not to lose heart. Prayer is a primary task of all Christians, and like the widow, it will prevail in the end.
