Belgian politicians have proposed widening the law to allow euthanasia for teenagers, terminally ill younger children, and the elderly who suffer from dementia. Belgium's Roman Catholic Cardinal Danneels denounced the practice of euthanasia. "Avoiding suffering is no act of bravery," "Our society seems unable to cope with death and suffering."
