Pope Benedict at Regensburg, Germany commented in our times the power of reason trivializes, ignores or rejects outright God as part of the discourse of human intelligence. Golf may lead to longer life

Golf could add an extra five years to the life spans of regular players, Swedish researchers say.

The study, performed by the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, contends that a close look at 500,000 golfs showed that there were many health benefits to playing the game, including a longer and healthier life. The golf study was published in the latest issue of the Scandinavian Journal of Medicine and Science in Sport.
