Gospel: John 2:13-25

The Jewish Temple originally was a great idea. It was the most important building in all of Judaism and their most sacred space. It allowed 1,000s to convene and added dignity to liturgies. It had become a noisy marketplace where practices of deceit, dishonesty, exploitation abounded. Within its walls, it had lost its spiritual soul. What was good in it got choked out by human commerce and greed.
