God as Father – Creator and Maker

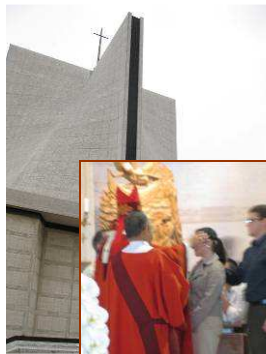
God as Son – Savior and Redeemer
