Vatican - The Synod on the Family

Synod is a result of Vatican II. It is to foster collegiality in the church and advise the Pontiff on important doctrinal matters to clarify unity. A synod has no legislative authority, only consultative. With families breaking up at an alarming rate because of spiritual despair and selfish individualism stable families beget stable societies and family is important to the survival of humanity learning morals that develop positive values. Over 200 attended the Synod. Bishops 114, Eastern Churches 13, Scholars 16, Invited 38, and Pope's invitees 8. They will meet again two more times.

National News

The U.S. enters a new war. The Church has concerns:

- 1. Relying on military forces never resolves what are primarily political problems. Political solutions must address the root causes;
- 2. As in the past, the advanced weapons the U.S. brings into wars getting into the wrong hands. ISIS fighters use American weapons today after Iraqi soldiers abandoned their posts. Afghanistan a similar problem with the Mujahedeen;
- 3. The U.S. has proved incapable after ten years in Iraqi of creating a self-sustaining moderate political movement. This means when conflict ends, chaos still prevails.

David Cortwright said, "Is the U.S. learning anything from its long and costly wars in the region."


