

[Part 1 of 15] Born in Mallorca, Spain, 1713. 1749 arrived to Mexico

His years in Mallorca, he would have witnessed the Jews expelled from the island, as well as the Muslims to North Africa. A plague wiped out 25% of the islands population. With little agricultural crops due to lack of rain, the island suffered famine regularly. The only stable institution against ignorance, wars, taxation, famine, unrest, poverty was the Catholic Church and its ageless way of seeing life. It offered hope and stability in a cruel and dangerous world. Mallorca was ruled by the Bourbon kings of Spain, a vital seaport island Palma ½ way between Spain and North Africa.
