LOST SHEEP - LOST COIN - LOST SON

Chapter 15 of Luke's gospel may be named as The Three Lost Parable: Lost Sheep, Lost Coin, and Lost Son.

Somebody may laugh at this gospel stories saying: "Jesus doesn't know math, and he doesn't know logic." If Jesus would have had to take a math exam, he might have failed. For Jesus, one lost sheep is equal to ninety-nine healthy ones, and perhaps more! Who could ever accept this?

To disturb the neighbors over one lost coin and then to plan a feast to celebrate the finding of the coin is truly illogical. How much does it cost for that feast? Not even all ten silver coins would be enough to cover the expenses. It is ridiculous.

But for Jesus, the joy of find the lost is more valuable than whatever the cost he has to

The prodigal son thinks he is entitled to his father's love. He is more of a thief, but the father loves him, no matter how bad the son was. The prodigal son parable assures us that God loves us unconditionally. God always opens wide his arms to embrace us even though we are sinners. Only one thing that God expects

from us is this: we have to repent, and come back to God, if we want to be forgiven and to be loved.

From the above parables, Jesus reveals the strange logic of his heart, saying: "Just so, I tell you, there is more joy... over one sinner who repents." A French philosopher, Blaise Pascal, also says: "the heart has its reasons that the mind doesn't know."
