WHAT HAVE I DONE FOR GOD & FOR THE CHURCH?

We don't want to hear about this truth, but the world will come to an end one day and our eternity will depend on the state of our conscience at the moment we depart.

Today's readings paint a somewhat frightening picture of the end-time. How would you and I answer if we were called by God to render an account of stewardship tonight? How do we stand in relationship with God, with neighbors, with creation, and with self? Malachi, Paul, and Jesus warn us about the Last Judgment: fire will consume the proud and evildoers, the destruction of the temple, war, earthquake, plague, famine, persecution, and even strife within families.

However, those are helpful warnings for us to avoid an unprepared end of our life. Malachi advises us to "fear the Lord." Jesus encourages us not to worry in times of trial, but to
