My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Lent is coming again. We will begin this forty-day journey with Ash Wednesday this week when we receive the ashes on our foreheads as a reminder for us to repent and believe in the Gospel. Lent invites us to pray, to fast, and to do the work of charity.

When Lent comes, people usually ask themselves: what do I give up for Lent? No meat? No alcohol? No cigarette? No chocolate? No gossiping? No TV? No computer? And so on... That is good as we try to give up some bad habits for Lent. But we should not forget the most important invitation for us, especially during Lent, is to "return to the Lord with your whole heart... Rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the Lord, your God." (cont.)
