St. Augustine once said: "O God, my heart is restless until it finds rest in you."

ancestor. But when Jesus asks her for some water to drink, he opens the eye of her soul to see things beyond, by revealing the truth that he himself is the fountain of living water. She eventually begs Jesus: "Lord, give me that living water."

The Lord invites us: "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts" (Ps 95:8). Moses strikes on the rock, and the water flows from it for people to drink and quench their thirst. Jesus is thirsty and he asks the Samaritan woman: "Give me

a drink!" He is asking you and me too. Let us allow Jesus to strike on our stony hearts so we may find in our hearts the living water, the love of God, Jesus Christ who is the source of our life.

Welcome baby **Joseph Michael McNeil** into our Catholic Faith through Baptism on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at St. Mary Church.


